

GEORGIA GOVERNOR'S HONORS PROGRAM

Position Announcement

Program Description: The Governor's Honors Program (GHP) is a six-week summer residential instructional program (four weeks in 2012) designed to provide intellectually gifted and artistically talented high school students challenging and enriching educational opportunities not usually available during the regular school year. Activities are designed to provide each participant with opportunities to acquire the skills, knowledge and attitudes to become independent, life-long learners. Annually, 690 students are selected to attend the program, currently held on the campus of Valdosta State University, in Valdosta, Georgia.

Title: Resident Assistant

Description of Duties: Provide general supervision of students, including conducting nightly hall checks, morning room checks, and periodic hall meetings; completing assigned desk duties, and conducting weekly seminars.

Minimum Qualifications: Applicants must have completed their sophomore year in college.

Preferred Qualifications: Have been a participant in the Georgia Governor's Honors Program or another Governor's School.

Application Deadline: Continuous recruitment. Interviews will begin in October, and will continue until all positions are filled.
